METHOD TO THE MISSION

To bring glory to God alone through the proclamation of the gospel and Christ-like care to those in need.

Under the guidance and direction of Jesus Christ, and the leading the Holy Spirit all for the glory of God alone, we desire to serve the LORD faithfully with all our heart (1 Samuel 12:24), considering what great things He has done for us. Declaring His glory among the nations, His marvelous works among all the peoples (Psalm 96:3). We are determined to present ourselves to God as one approved, unashamed, rightly handling the word of truth (2 Timothy 2:15). For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them (Ephesians 2:10).

As a bible-obedient ministry, our first priority is to love the Lord our God with all our heart, with all our soul, and with all our mind (Matthew 22:37). We do this by complete obedience to Scripture as the final authority as the Holy Spirit leads us to develop initiatives that bring glory to God and hope to those in need. We reject the practice of catering to culture and practicing our righteousness before other people in order to be seen by them (Matthew 6:1-4), but rather stand firm on the Word of God and choose Christ over culture, for He is our reward.

We are committed to loving our neighbor as ourselves (Matthew 22:39). Pouring ourselves out for the hungry and satisfying the desire of the afflicted, so that our light shall rise in the darkness (Isaiah 58:10). In knowing that for our sake God made him be sin who knew no sin so that in him we might become the righteousness of God, we devote our entire life to proclaiming Christ. We train, equip and teach the body of Christ and conduct evangelistic outreach as ambassadors for Christ, imploring the lost to be reconciled to God through Christ Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:18-21).

We collaborate with authentic biblical believers, ministries, missionaries, and churches around the world to strengthen our united efforts theologically, strategically, logistically, and financially. For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another (Romans 12:4-5).

We are brothers and sisters in Christ, predestined by God for adoption as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of His will (Ephesians 1:5). We want our love to be genuine. Abhorring what is evil; holding fast to what is good. We desire to love one another with brotherly affection. Outdoing one another in showing honor (Romans 12:9-20). As each has received a gift, we will use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace: whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God; whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies—in order that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ (1 Peter 4:10-12).

We cast our hearts upon the poor, the orphan, and the widow and show Christ-like compassion. With discernment and biblical wisdom, we reach out to those in distress directly and through collaborations to provide care and relief. Where there is thirst, water. Where there is hunger, nutrition. Where there is no home, shelter. Where there is no access to knowledge, education. We are committed to doing that which is pure and undefiled before God, the Father, caring for the orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep ourselves unstained from the world (James 1:27).



Together Dwight and Cristi operate their ministry United Ministries Gospel Outreach (UMGO) and offer support wherever there is a need and wherever God leads.

In 2022, with the support of generous donors and our ministry partners, we were able to offer assistance and relief goods to families affected by Typhoon Rai (also known as Odette) in Mabua, Surigao. Additionally, we discovered an unreached group of people in the area and were able to provide them with relief goods and share the good news of Jesus Christ with them.

Dwight recently underwent a procedure called Coronary Angiogram, which revealed blocked arteries in his heart. The doctors recommended an open heart operation, but instead, Dwight underwent Coronary Angioplasty twice. During these procedures, two stents were placed in his arteries, and he spent a total of 8 days in the hospital.

We are thankful for the prayers and financial support that helped us through this challenging time.

It brings us joy to see many young people getting baptized and growing in their faith. We started hosting a monthly gathering for young adults which is forming into a church plant at our home on Sundays. These young adults come from three different municipalities in the Albay province, with the farthest traveling 25 miles to join us. Most of them rely on public transportation, which can be difficult at times. During our gatherings, we pray, worship through songs, watch sermons by Pastor Joel Beeke, enjoy a fellowship meal, and have a Q&A session. It's a time of spiritual growth and connection. We are excited to support Bro. Bien, the leader of our young adult group, as he embarks on a journey to Bicol Center for Christian Leadership (BCCL)

for formal ministry training. He will be enrolled in a five-modular course that will grant him a Certificate in Leadership Foundation (CLF). This program is designed to equip emerging leaders with foundational knowledge and skills for spiritual leadership.

We have been actively involved in supporting the group's children's outreach efforts. We provide teaching materials, teaching aids, toys, and books that we receive from Balikbayan boxes sent from America. Additionally, we offer simple snacks to the children during these outreach programs. In October, we were able to provide financial assistance to sister Suellen, who was severely affected by flooding in Sultan Kudarat, located 580 miles away from us. The flooding was caused by Severe Tropical Storm Nalgae, locally known as Paeng. Many families were displaced, including Suellen and her five young children.

Thankfully, they were rescued and brought to safety without any injuries. We are grateful that we could offer support during this difficult time.

With the help of our young adults, led by Bien and Mika, we distributed Christmas packs containing Gospel tracts to families in Guinobatan during the Children's Thanksgiving Celebration. We provided funds for the food and some toys from the Balikbayan Box sent from the US. The young adults cooked, prepared the program, wrapped the toys, and shared the Good News with the children using beaded bracelets. It was a wonderful way to spread joy and the message of God's love.

In all the things we have accomplished and so much more in 2022, we give thanks, honor, and glory to God the Father through Jesus Christ our Lord.

We have partnered with Evangelical Baptist Church in India. We supported the Pastors Training Institute (RBPTI) and hope to expand our partnership to preach the gospel and plant reformed churches in unreached villages. The institute trains pastors biblical theology, many from a Pentecostal background. Through this ministry churches have become reformed and other pastors can faced opposition for trying to bring their local church back to biblical truth. Also, many theology books have been translated into their native language where previously these materials were never available. Through this church, The Hope Movement has supported teachers' salaries at Bethshan Special School in India. The school was established with the holistic aim of helping the mentally challenged children in the community.

Our dear brother Daniel Courtney is a missionary in Nepal, where evangelizing is illegal. However, he is open-air preaches daily, trains Christians, planted a reformed house church, and operates an orphanage for girls along with his wife and children. We have been able to send financial support thanks to our faithful donors.

UKRAINE DISASTER RELIEF




ABOLISH ABORTION MOVEMENT

The marriage is not good, so she thought the best option was to murder her children. When she arrived at the abortion mill, she heard a Christian preaching the gospel. She walked into the abortion mill, paid the fee, and received a sonogram. They informed her she was having twins. While inside the abortion mill, she could still hear the preaching of the gospel. Feeling convicted, she told the abortionist that she wanted to go outside to think. The abortionist said, "If you wait, it will be more expensive as those babies are getting bigger." She went outside, and the Christian called her over and pleaded to behave for the lives of the babies. That day she changed her mind. Later our team took her to dinner, gave her a blessing bag, and connected her to resources to help with living expenses and a baby registry. On Saturday, October 15, 2022, we had a beautiful baby shower for her two baby girls, who will be born in January. Hannah, Erika, Michael, Noah, Brandon, and Jeff did a wonderful job organizing this event.




