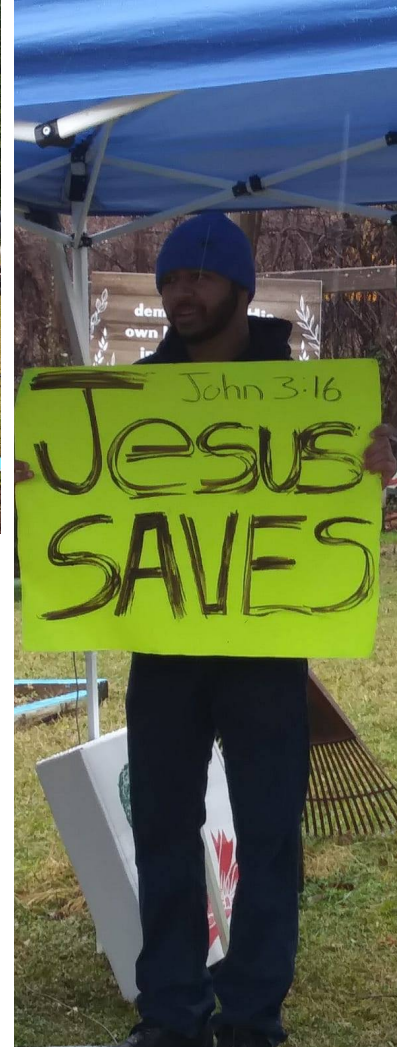

May the passion of hearts and the testimony of our actions be Christ-centered and God glorifying. For our purpose on this earth is to bring God alone glory, our call as Christians is to make disciples through the power of His word.

2003 – 2004: FOUNDING

When our founder started The Hope Movement 14 years ago he was a kid with a dream. No money, no connections, only a pain in his heart for those in need and a calling from God to help them. A few friends, family members and even strangers heard the cry of his heart and took a chance in believing in him and gave, opening the door to start The Hope Movement.

2005 – 2007: BEGINNINGS

Since then because of your financial support we have built a home for a family in El Salvador, a roof of a church in Costa Rica which now has hundreds of members and supports feeding programs in Haiti, found the family of a child being deported from the U.S. to Mexico, raised awareness about human trafficking, fed the hungry in the amazons of Iquitos, Peru, fed children in the Philippines.

2008–2017: EXPANSION

Provided mosquito nets in Africa to prevent malaria, fed and evangelized to Muslim and Hindu communities in Bangladesh, provided tens of thousands of meals in Guatemala and Kenya, transformed the lives of children with cleft lip, organized medical missions providing free health care, installed a water well for an indigenous community, evangelized in nearly every continent, preached the Gospel in public schools, started a Bible Institute in Guatemala raising up the next generation of leaders, rescued women and children from abuse, provided education and counseling to hundreds, launched two online weekly theology classes in English and Spanish as well as other teaching series, provided wheelchairs to children and adults, we helped with hurricane relief in the United States, evangelized in the streets,, provided shelter and scholarships for 120 orphans in Kenya, registered as a non-profit in Kenya, transformed vacant lots in Baltimore City into Haven of Hope Community Gardens while proclaiming the gospel, praying with the people and meeting their physical needs.

2018: TO THE GLORY OF GOD

In 2018 just to name a few things that took place, over 52,233 meals were served, continued supporting feeding centers in Guatemala, funded treatment for child with brain complications, in Kenya, 120 orphans attended school through our scholarships, orphans in received food, shoes, clothing, we provided housing to all 120 orphans, 25 churches united under The

Hope Movement, we installed water pump provide fresh water to thousands, over 120 Swahili Bibles were distributed, continued our bible school, we conducted a mission trip where we proclaimed the gospel, we translated evangelistic materials in Swahili and Spanish, we continued our theology education and added a Man-Up series for biblical manhood, we continued our work with our community garden, evangelizing and providing food, clothing, and prayer to people in Baltimore City.

ABOUT US:

The Hope Movement is a 501 (c) (3) Christian ministry with a mission is to shake the comfort zone of God's people to renew our minds, uniting us as one to impact lives through evangelistic, holistic and transformative methods to bring nations closer to Jesus Christ, breaking the cycle of spiritual and physical poverty and loosening the chains of bondage.

The Hope Movement is not an organization or a one-man show. We are a movement of believers predestined for good works united as one, dedicating our lives to the glorification of God through word and deed, caring for those living in desperate need. A new day has arrived and the Hope Movement is the formation of a generation of transformation.

Method to the Mission:

Under the guidance and direction of Jesus Christ, and the leading the Holy Spirit all for the glory of God alone, we desire to serve the LORD faithfully with all our heart (1 Samuel 12:24), considering what great things He has done for us. Declaring His glory among the nations, His marvelous works among all the peoples (Psalm 96:3). We are determined to present ourselves to God as one approved, unashamed, rightly handling the word of truth (2 Timothy 2:15). For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them (Ephesians 2:10).

As a bible-obedient ministry, our first priority is to love the Lord our God with all our heart, with all our soul, and with all our mind (Matthew 22:37). We do this by complete obedience to Scripture as the final authority as the Holy Spirit leads us to develop initiatives that bring glory to God and hope to those in need. We reject the practice of catering to culture and practicing our righteousness before other people in order to be seen by them (Matthew 6:1-4), but rather stand firm on the Word of God and choose Christ over culture, for He is our reward.

We are committed to loving our neighbor as our self (Matthew 22:39). Pouring ourselves out for the hungry and satisfying the desire of the afflicted, so that our light shall rise in the darkness (Isaiah 58:10). In knowing that for our sake God made him to be sin who knew no sin so that in him we might become the righteousness of God, we devote our entire life to proclaiming Christ. We train, equip and teach the body of Christ and conduct evangelistic outreach as ambassadors for Christ, imploring the lost to be reconciled to God through Christ Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:18-21).

We collaborate with authentic biblical believers, ministries, missionaries, and churches around the world to strengthen our united efforts theologically, strategically, logistically and financially. For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, so we, though

many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another (Romans 12:4-5). We are brothers and sisters in Christ, predestined by God for adoption as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of His will (Ephesians 1:5). We want our love to be genuine. Abhorring what is evil; holding fast to what is good. We desire to love one another with brotherly affection. Outdoing one another in showing honor (Romans 12:9-20). As each has received a gift, we will use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace: whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God; whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies—in order that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ (1 Peter 4:10-12).

We cast our hearts upon the poor, the orphan and widow and show Christ-like compassion. With discernment and biblical wisdom, we reach out to those in distress directly and through collaborations to provide care and relief. Where there is thirst, water. Where there is hunger, nutrition. Where there is no home, shelter. Where there is no access to knowledge, education. We are committed to doing that which is pure and undefiled before God, the Father, caring for the orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep ourselves unstained from the world (James 1:27).

Therefore, having this ministry by the mercy of God, we do not lose heart. However, we have renounced disgraceful, underhanded ways. We refuse to practice cunning or to tamper with God's word, but by the open statement of the truth, we would commend ourselves to everyone's conscience in the sight of God. For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ (2 Corinthians 4:1-6).



1 POVERTY RELIEF

Feeding the Hungry

The Hope Movement provides nutrition to those in desperate need of food in collaboration with sharing the Gospel and providing other resources to meet their spiritual and physical development.

Orphan and Widows

The Hope Movement answers the Christian's call to care for the orphan and widow through the support of orphanages and church-based foster programs around the world.

Love of Neighbor

The Hope Movement under the guidance of the Holy Spirit respond to the cries of help from those in need around the world. Help can come in many forms. We serve those in need to break the cycle of poverty and most importantly show the love of Christ not just through deeds but through the preaching of the Gospel so that they may be saved and in Christ Jesus.

Quality Education

The Hope Movement provides scholarships to children so that they can attend school from primary to college. We also develop education programs in our church-based centers to teach children theology, reading, writing and mathematics and assist them with their school studies.

HOPE FOR KENYA

In Kenya, Africa there is a wonderful man named Pastor Fredrick Manhanu. He pastors a small church and has a heart for the poor. For the last 5 years Pastor Fredrick has been working with 120 orphans who lost their parents because of HIV/AIDS, Malaria or abandonment. Not

having an orphanage he did something creative, he called upon the church to be the hands of God and open their homes to these precious children. The church members responded and that birthed a foster program where church members are caretakers of these 120 orphans.

Nafula, Sofia Nekesa, Hillkia Walekhwa, Faith Neema are in High School and 115 other orphans are in primary school all because of your donation. Along with this exciting news we also now have 25 churches, conducting Bible studies and providing Bibles in Swahili every month.



SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

The Hope Movement provided all 120 orphans food, supplies and scholarships to attend school.

Deborah Murunga is now in college studying to be a teacher and hopes to teach orphans if God allows us to open our own school, KERREN

KENYA



MISSION TRIP

The moment we arrived in Kenya we basically began working. On Day 1 we traveled to a local church where Pastor Frederick pastors. The orphans did a beautiful presentation of worship songs and Bible verse memorization. Shawn and Jonathan tag teamed the message as they shared about the Attributes of God and proclaimed the gospel. We then distributed Bibles in Swahili to people who needed them and later that evening we distributed donations as we brought with us 250 pounds of clothing and shoes. This was a wonderful time we spent with our orphaned children who are in our care.

Day 2 we traveled to St. Elizabeth's Primary School, a public school where The Hope Movement installed a water well pump providing water for all 500 students and 5,000 in the community. We were able to visit the well and see it being used by the children. We then met with the school staff and the students. Shawn shared his testimony of being an atheist and now a believer

in Christ. Jonathan shared a gospel presentation. From there we traveled down dirt roads to a small church building made of mud. There we taught theology and a sermon on Christ throughout the Scriptures. At the end of the sermon, an elderly woman walked up to us, layed a cloth on the dirt floor and knelt down and with tears in her eyes said she wants Christ. We explained to her about repentance and Christian living and we prayed. As we were praying Pastor Frederick whispered to Jonathan and translated what she was saying in Swahili, she was repenting of her sins. Pray that this was genuine repentance and that she will grow in Christ.

Day 3 we traveled once again through dirt roads to a newly planted home church. They had a tent in the front and greeted us with drums and song. There we shared the attributes of God and Jonathan shared a special word of encouragement and message of warning for this church. The moment the

sermon was over it began to rain so strong it blew away the tent. We all crammed inside of this small home with no electricity. They gave us something to drink and snacks. Then children came in a sang a worship song. From there we jumped into the vehicle and drove 30-40 minutes to another church. This church is located in an area with much false teaching. Shawn preached on the divinity of Christ and Jonathan on what it means to be a follower of Christ.

Day 4 was an amazing day with 2 separate sermon sessions. First, we had all the orphans and members of the church. The children did a beautiful song and bible verse memorization presentation. There we were able to teach theology and present the gospel. Later Jonathan taught on a verse by verse breakdown of Ephesians 5. Then after lunch, we returned to the church and preached for 2 hours on the Doctrines of Grace. It was beautiful to see God glorified, people receiving, accepting and loving the truth of God's word. In closing that day we distributed once again more clothing to the children.

Day 5 was our final day in



Kenya. We were on our way to church and the car broke down and so we got into an auto rickshaw and arrived at the church. There was a beautiful time of worship and then Shawn shared on the great commission. Then Jonathan preached the final sermon, a verse by verse exposition of Philippians 2. From there we ate one last lunch together and then traveled 2 hours to Kisumu, the first of 4 airports. While there a tropical type storm came through and the electricity turned off several times in the airport. After a delay in the flight we were on our way to return to our families in the U.S. but with joy in our hearts and love for the people we met as the gospel was proclaimed and God was glorified.



WATER WELL FOR A SCHOOL

August 8, 2018 was an exciting day. The Hope Movement by the provision of God was able to purchase and install a pump for a water well in Kenya. This well will provide water for over 500 students of a public school where some of our orphans attend as well as to over 5,000 people in the local community.



MEDICAL TREATMENT AND SHOES

Life is not easy in Kenya for many children they can often suffer from suffering from malaria, scabies, chronic skin infection and mumps. Because of lack of shoes some children were bitten by an insect called jiggers or Tunga penetrans. These insects embed themselves in the skin and feed on flesh. We not only provided medical treatment but purchased shoes for all 120 orphans to prevent future issues.



GUATEMALA



Although 2017 brought unexpected changes in our projects in Guatemala, we understand God is sovereign over all things and is working all things for His glory and our good. In 2018, our other 3 feeding centers continued serving those in need and teaching the Bible providing thousands of meals. We were also by the grace of God able to help another wonderful project in Chiquimula, Guatemala who are serving the poor living and working in the trash dump. We pray we have the finances to continue our work in Guatemala and expand it. We are also planning a mission in 2019 to Guatemala to teach theology and evaluate current and potential projects.

PROJECT 003: NUEVO AMANECER

This center is located in Guatemala City in Nuevo Amanecer providing weekly meals, counseling, and Biblical theology classes.

PROJECT 004: SAN JUAN

This center is located in San Juan, Sacatepequez providing weekly meals, counseling, and Biblical theology classes.

PROJECT 005: VILLA LOBOS

This center is located in Guatemala City in Villa Lobos providing weekly meals, counseling, and Biblical theology classes.

CHIQUIMULA

We assisted a ministry which we hope to partner with in the future to serve the people living in a trash dump. We provided financial support for feeding programs and guitars for music classes.

PROVIDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL HELP

We were able to help a Christian family who lead a small church in the mountains of San Juan Sacatepequez. Their son Pedro Jose was having convulsions and has fluid on the brain. The financial assistance helped over the emergency surgery.

NEW TABLES FOR FEEDING CENTER

We were able to purchase new tables thanks to the support of donors for our feeding center in Villa Lobos, Guatemala

EMERGENCY DISASTER RELIEF

In June, Guatemala had a natural disaster when a volcano erupted and wiped out entire towns, killing hundreds. One of our feeding center church locations provided shelter and food for victims and emergency workers. We were able to send funds to support their efforts, providing emergency relief to the people affected by the devastation.



The Hope Movement working along with local churches, community leaders and the community itself has a vision to develop a strategic plan of action to transform the most impoverished communities in Baltimore City into havens of hope.

FROM VACANT LOTS TO HAVENS OF HOPE

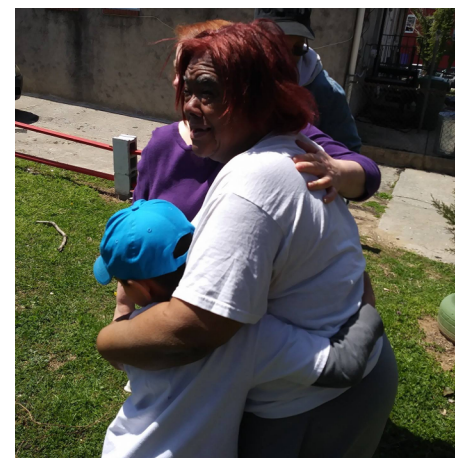
Baltimore City has developed an agreement with The Hope Movement to adopt and manage vacant lots where gangs, poverty, drugs, alcoholism, violence and family dysfunction are consuming the people. The Hope Movement mobilizes a local movement of people from churches, businesses and individuals from the

community to unite and volunteer their time to develop these lots into community gardens, safe parks for families and we provide food programs, prayer and evangelism.

The vacant lots we have been working on in 2017 are located on the notorious North Avenue, known for the riots in 2015 and was abandoned with high grass, hanging branches, trash, mattresses for the homeless and prostitution, drug needles and more. But today its a place with flowers, vegetables for the community, places to sit, signs with Bible verses with a beautiful fence creating a haven of hope in the midst of despair.

EVANGELISM

The Hope Movement has teams working on community development in the garden and feeding programs and another team for evangelism. We preach the Gospel with boldness to open the eyes through the power of the Holy Spirit and His Word planting seeds in their hearts and calling them to repentance.





COMMUNITY OUTREACH

In 2018, God expanded our team of local missionaries from various churches. It has been wonderful to see the body of Christ uniting as one to proclaim the gospel, pray with people, feed the hungry, distribute clothing, care for the community garden while encouraging other brothers and sisters in Christ. Throughout the year we not only maintained the community garden and

planted flowers and vegetables. We had many opportunities to street preach and pray with people, sharing the gospel and the hope only found in Christ.

We also held many events united with different churches such as Life Source and Faith Fellowship Church.

Just to share about a couple of the outreaches in November we had a full course Thanksgiving meal. God was gracious to us and held back the rain until the moment we were finished. Served a complete thanksgiving dinner to about 100 people in the community, shared the gospel and prayed for individuals. In December, over 100 bowls of chili, hamburgers, corn bread, cookies and coffee served.

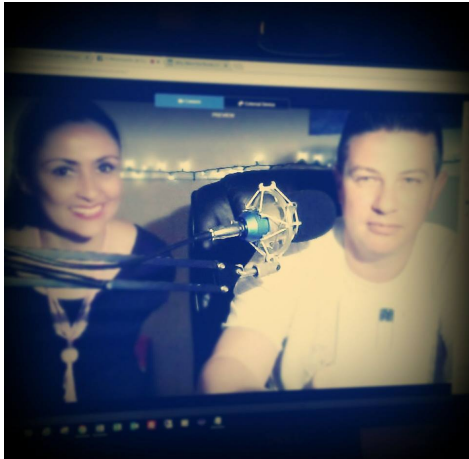
Through a simple community garden that was a vacant lot in a dangerous part of the city, God has provided wonderful opportunities to pray with people and share the love of Christ.

May God be glorified and people come to Christ.





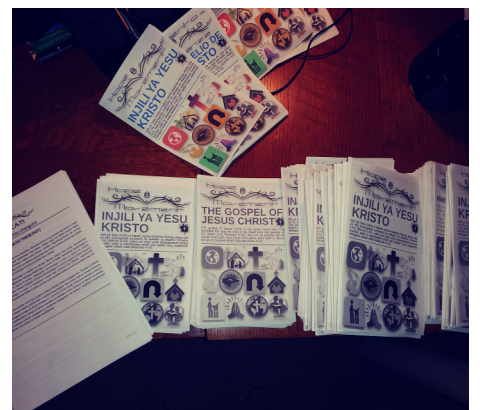
THEOLOGY FAMINE RELIEF

Because of our fear of God and love of His word, we carefully teach indisputable truths of the Bible in order to glorify God and bring man to a deeper understanding of Him allowing the Holy Spirit to regenerate souls to bring them to repentance and salvation.

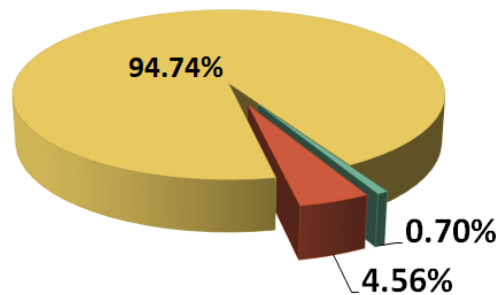
The Hope Movement produces materials and teaches using a systematic theology approach. "Systematic" refers to something being put into a system. Systematic theology is, therefore, the division of theology into systems that explain its various areas.

The Hope Movement along with preaching the Gospel and teaching theology in churches, conferences, seminars and outreach missions, we also preach and teach through our online broadcast in various languages every week, which have been watched by hundreds of people around the world.

In 2018 we continued our weekly theology classes in English and Spanish, designed shirts with theology words and Bible verses to share the Gospel, published Gospel brochures and teaching guides in various languages, began an remix album of old hymns, began the writing of a new theology book and trained pastors from Kenya and other countries.

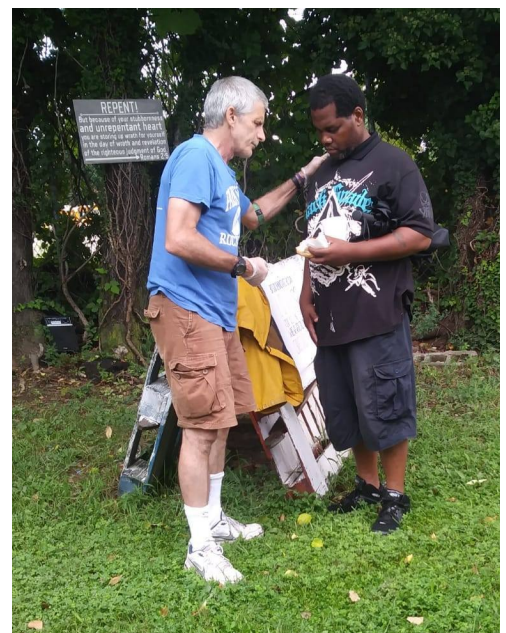
