THE DNA OF CALLING

We are all called to be the hands of God, serving Him is our responsibility, its in our spiritual DNA. Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) is a molecule that encodes the genetic instructions used in the development and functioning of all known living organisms and many viruses. Calling is defined as a strong inner impulse toward a particular course of action especially when accompanied by conviction of divine influence. So when God formed the DNA of a Christian, he developed a new genetic instruction that guides our purpose in life, this is our calling.

When we reject this calling, we are trying to alter our Christian DNA. Studies show that when humans try to alter DNA there are many risks including health problems and activation of dominate viruses. Rejecting or trying to alter our spiritual DNA separates us from God, grieves His heart and makes us vulnerable to spiritual contamination.



In order to serve God we must see life through His eyes. The Jews have a legend that when their forefathers were saved from Egypt and the Egyptians drowned in the Red Sea, the angels joined the songs of triumph sung by the Israeli's, and God said to the angels, "The Jews are men and can rejoice about their escape, but from you I expect more understanding. Are the Egyptians not also my creatures? Do I not love them, too? How do you fail to feel my sorrow about their tragic fate?"

Joshua 5:13 says, "And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, a Man stood opposite him with His sword drawn in His hand, and Joshua went to Him and said to Him, "Are you for us or for our adversaries."

If the one met by Joshua had been only a man, the answer could have been "I am for you" or "I am for your adversaries", or even "I am neutral". These are the only possible human responses to such a question. But the Being whom Joshua met was from the Lord and, therefore, when asked whether He was for or against Israel, gave an answer that is most unexpected and difficult to understand; "No". What does this "no" mean?

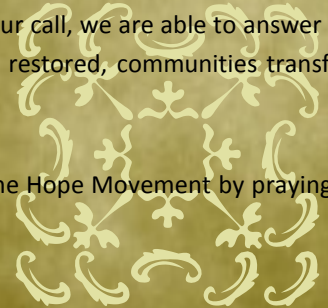
He came from a place where beings are not for or against, but where everyone and everything are understood, looked upon with pity and compassion, and loved with fire.

Feeding The Hungry

It is our desire to give hope to children and families around the world by giving them the nourishment they need to make it through another day. We're also helping children with basic education and sharing the story of God's great love. Lives are being saved by a simple meal and changed by the love of God.

Some children who come to our Haven of Hope and nationwide feeding programs have experienced the nightmare of neglect and abuse. Others are loved but forced to work due to extreme poverty. Still others come from homes with parents who are physically disabled or who make their living by prostitution. In fact, for many children the care and education they receive at our feeding programs are the only things that stand between them and a similar fate.

In 2013 we provided over 10,000 meals to hungry children around the world.

And our impact goes far beyond the lives of the children. Because of our compassionate outreaches, many of their parents accept Christ and begin to attend the local churches as a family. In fact, we are seeing whole communities gradually change as we focus on simply providing meals for the children and meeting their needs.

Education

The surest path out of poverty is education. Unfortunately, education is sometimes considered a luxury by impoverished families, and even those who value it often find it difficult to afford. We provide a variety of education opportunities to children and adults through programs such as basic education classes, tutoring, computer classes, vocational education, Leadership Development and Biblical education.

Empowering poor children and youth takes specialized programs to ensure that they have the skills and abilities they'll need to become self-sufficient adults capable of escaping poverty.



In 2013 we conducted over 106 education events for children and families.



In 2013 we conducted family counseling classes and seminars to over 113 families.

Family Structure

Our specially trained and licensed social workers in our Haven of Hope Centers and in worldwide alliances incorporate our costumed designed curriculum to teach, train, and empower adults, igniting a passion to find their life's purpose, spiritual connection, and to step outside of their comfort zone providing them with the essential tools to become leaders and vessels of change, bringing transformation to their families, friends, community, and nation.

We offer two unique programs for adults to help them become better role-models, parents, and leaders in their community.

Parents of Purpose is a creative program that utilizes one-on-one and group mentorship to assist parents in becoming better parents to their children, overcoming obstacles, and stabilizing the family structure.

Evangelism/ Social Activism

God has chosen to have us work with Him to bring justice to victims of oppression, for we are His hands. The truth is that He calls all people to seek justice for the abused and suffering in our world. God's people often do not understand that social work goes hand and hand with spiritual outreach. You can't have one without the other. Jesus always combined social and spiritual outreach together. He would not only preach to the people about spiritual salvation but he would feed the hungry, heal their bodies, and pull them out of the life of prostitution, addiction, and oppression.

The Hope Movement unifies God's people, shakes them from their comfort zone and take fearless action. We take the message of Jesus Christ to the people and meet them where they are, the streets, schools, homes, gang territory, churches and nations where it is illegal to proclaim the name of Jesus Christ.

Through our spiritual outreach we not only rescue from spiritual oppression but make every effort to deliver them from grips of addiction, rescue them from the streets and liberate them from the chains of human trafficking.



In 2013 we preached the love of Jesus in schools, streets, churches and in poverty and violence consumed communities.



Missions

Our mission teams conduct life transforming activities in schools, reach out to people throughout the community, minister in shelters and visit local families providing counseling and education. Hundreds of local churches, ministries, non-profits and community members are united as one and dedicate their time and talents to assist in community outreaches, street crusades, feeding the hungry, repairing homes, and building water wells, combating human trafficking, bringing restoration to families and neighborhoods.

Mission teams speak to local churches and ministries sharing the vision of God, uniting them as one and inspiring them to step outside of their comfort zone, establishing a Hope Movement Alliance to maintain the development of these communities.

In 2013 we worked in unreached communities ministering to the needs of people through united efforts with local churches.

Medical

The Hope Movement in partnership with local ministries and medical professionals is developing medical mission teams in several nations such as Guatemala providing medical care to indigenous Indians and people living in impoverished conditions who do not have access to basic health care treatment and education.

Our medical mission teams travel to various cities, distant villages and work in clinics providing hygiene care and education, dental examines, blood tests, mammograms, HIV/AIDS testing, physicals, and other life saving treatment. Prevention education is essential in saving lives. Throughout the community our teams provide education on subjects such as Abstinence, Safe Practices Methods, HIV/AIDS, Breast Cancer, Prostate Cancer, Cervical Cancer, Hygiene, and many life threatening diseases.

Use of existing, low-cost tools and knowledge could save more than 6 million of the 9.7 million children who die yearly from easily preventable or curable causes.



We unite with ministries and communities who lack resources and organize medical missions saving lives.



In 2013 we developed a partnership a local church in Guatemala City to provide a weekly feeding program in their church.

Haven of Hope

Located in the Colonia of Madrid and San Felipe, our Haven of Hope is the only outreach center in the third largest city in Guatemala, providing nutritious meals daily to the most vulnerable of children in the community, children who most days live on less than a piece of bread a day, and spend their time in the streets begging and searching for food for their families. A nutritious meal is essential for survival and development. In attending the Haven of Hope The Hope Movement does not just provide physical nourishment, but through education and counseling we provide spiritual and emotional nourishment to guide children, heal their inner wounds, and inspire them to pursue their life's purpose, understanding that poverty is not their destiny, it is only an obstacle to overcome to make their dreams into a reality.

We provide weekly feeding programs, education classes, counseling sessions, medical care and soon will be launching a café for youth, a place to enjoy live Christian music, poetry, coffee and Biblical conversation.

Global United Programs

We partner with local churches, helping to strengthen local leadership and equipping them with resources and training to carry out our shared mission among the poor and oppressed. Churches often times have passionate staff and volunteers from their congregation who feel called to minister to those in need in their community, they also have a building but don't have resources to launch an effective program. A heavy cost burden is maintaining a facility and paying salaries, but partnering with churches, we can do more with less money, by unifying and utilizing resources in an effective fruitful way to bring hope to more people in need. Our commitment is that communities will be transformed into thriving havens of hope through engaged churches who work diligently to sustain spiritual and physical transformation.

The Hope Movement is an expression of the Church on special assignment to care for those who are poor and oppressed. Churches are our indispensable partners in God's mission. Together we are The Hope Movement.



In 2013 we provided food, education, counseling, medical care, spiritual guidance and community outreach to over 6,000 children.



Gifts of Love

Throughout the year The Hope Movement collected toys, clothing, shoes, school supplies, office supplies, food and wheelchairs and distributed needed items to hundreds of families. Through the efforts of The Hope Movement team and our donors children received a wheelchair so they can live a more productive life, children enjoyed a Christmas to remember, and lives were transformed by supplies provided for our feeding and education programs.

In the United States, Publix, a major super market donated gift cards, and The Hope Movement in partnership with Charter Schools USA gave needy families in South Florida these gift cards so that they can feed their hungry families during the holiday season.

In 2013 we provided a Christmas to over 200 children in several nations including the United States.

Future Plans

Home for Children

The Hope Movement has been called to rescue children from abuse and abandonment, and have developed a home for those who have been abused and abandoned by their families and society, providing them with a safe haven, a place to live, gain knowledge, and make new memories in a positive family atmosphere. In June of 2014 we a mission team will build a second level to the Haven of Hope to open our new home for children.

Manna del Cielo

The Hope Movement is developing our own food production and distribution center which will develop a food mixture call Manna del Cielo that would be easy and safe to transport, simple to make with only boiling water, and culturally acceptable worldwide. Moringa contains more than 90 nutrients and 46 antioxidants, and one ounce provides enough nutrients for a malnourished child for a month.

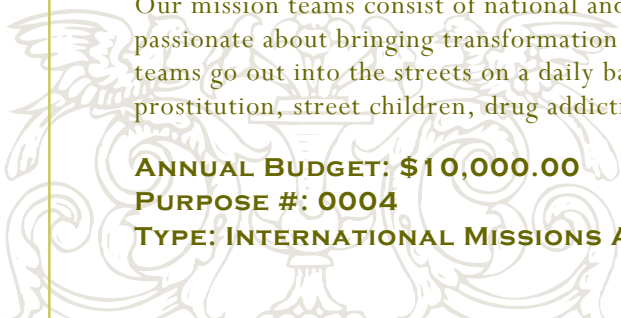

WHO WE ARE

The Hope Movement is a 501 (c)(3) non-profit movement with a passion to bring social and spiritual change throughout the world. Our vision to create a revolution of love throughout the world opening the windows of heaven to allow the rain of God's presence to fall upon His people, flowing through the streets like a mighty river, pouring hope into the lives of many.

Our mission is to unite non-profits, churches, ministries, and individuals together as one in a movement of hope, shaking the comfort zone and inspiring them to work together to bring hope to those in need. We will defend and care for abused and abandoned children, embracing them with arms of love. We will protect the defenseless and break the chains of slavery. We will provide spiritual and physical nourishment to those in need so that they may live long and prosperous lives. We will empower the people through education, counseling and spiritual development, creating a cycle of change, releasing them from the trap of addiction and oppression. We will stabilize the family structure inspiring parents of purpose who rise up as leaders in their home and community. We will preach a message of hope to everyone in our path, opening their eyes to see their life's purpose, being the voice and the hands of God, transforming communities into havens of hope.

The Hope Movement is not an organization, or a one man show. It is a movement of destined individuals united as one, dedicating our lives to the rescue and care of children and adults living in desperate need, reaching out to those who are longing for love. A new day has arrived and the Hope Movement is the formation of a generation of transformation.

Through life-transforming programs, initiatives, outreach centers, and mission work in the streets united with others, the Hope Movement confronts human suffering: violence that strips widows and orphans of their property and livelihoods, poverty that drains families of hope, family dysfunction that causes children to make their beds in the streets, hunger that consumes life with inner pain, addiction that pollutes the soul, abuse that rips innocence from a child and robs of them a peaceful future, violence that steals dignity and health from children trafficked into forced prostitution, violence that denies freedom and security to families trapped in slavery.

Suffering of the poor is not driven by the overwhelming power of the perpetrators – it is driven by the vulnerability of the victims, and the lack of unity and passionate individuals who will step out of their comfort zone, unite, and reach those who are longing for hope. This suffering can be stopped when the power of God is released to flood the streets with hope, transforming communities into havens of hope, and when we step out of our comfort zone, and unite to become a movement of hope. One person unites with another and becomes a ripple, as more unite they become a movement, forming a flood of hope, flowing through the streets, transforming all that is in their path with the power of unified actions of love.

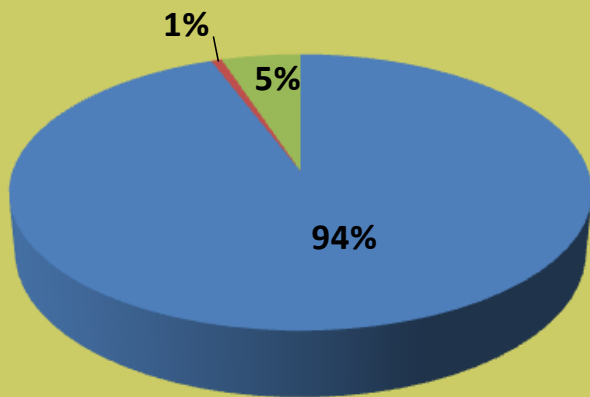
