May the passion of hearts and the testimony of our actions be Christ-centered and God glorifying. For our purpose on this earth is to bring God alone glory, our call as Christians is to make disciples through the power of His word.

2003 – 2004: FOUNDING

When our founder started The Hope Movement 14 years ago he was a kid with a dream. No money, no connections, only a pain in his heart for those in need and a calling from God to help them. A few friends, family members and even strangers heard the cry of his heart and took a chance in believing in him and gave, opening the door to start The Hope Movement.

2005 – 2007: BEGINNINGS

Since then because of your financial support we have built a home for a family in El Salvador, a roof of a church in Costa Rica which now has hundreds of members and supports feeding programs in Haiti, found the family of a child being deported from the U.S. to Mexico, raised awareness about human trafficking, fed the hungry in the amazons of Iquitos, Peru, fed children in the Philippines.

2008–2017: EXPANSION

Provided mosquito nets in Africa to prevent malaria, fed and evangelized to Muslim and Hindu communities in Bangladesh, provided tens of thousands of meals in Guatemala and Kenya, transformed the lives of children with cleft lip, organized medical missions providing free health care, installed a water well for an indigenous community, evangelized in nearly every continent, preached the Gospel in public schools, started a Bible Institute in Guatemala raising up the next generation of leaders, rescued women and children from abuse, provided education and counseling to hundreds, launched two online weekly theology classes in English and Spanish as well as other teaching series, provided wheelchairs to children and adults, we helped with hurricane relief in the United States, evangelized in the streets, provided shelter and scholarships for 120 orphans in Kenya, registered as a non-profit in Kenya, transformed vacant lots in Baltimore City into Haven of Hope Community Gardens while proclaiming the gospel, praying with the people and meeting their physical needs.

2019: TO THE GLORY OF GOD

In 2019 just to name a few things that took place, over 51,927 meals were served. In Guatemala, we supported feeding centers, funded treatment for a child with brain complications, and conducted a mission trip preaching in churches, prisons, hospitals, trash dumps, and shelters. In Kenya, 120 orphans attended school through our scholarships,



Deborah, one of our orphans graduated from High School. orphans received food, shoes, clothing, and housing. several churches were planted, over 120 Swahili Bibles were distributed, we continued our bible school and sent pastors to several conferences for further training. In the Philippines, we purchased a vehicle for our mission partners Dwight and Cristi Spears. They were able to assist local churches, provide food to the needy, distributed Bibles and evangelistic materials in the native language, assisted with typhoon relief and shared the gospel to many. In Baltimore, we continued our work with our community garden, evangelizing and providing food, clothing, and prayer to over 1,500 people. Hope Movement Publications developed new evangelistic shirts, we developed two new tracts and translated evangelistic materials in Swahili and Spanish, and we continued our theology education through online video teaching series which reached thousands around the world.

Our Mission:

To bring glory to God alone through the proclamation of the gospel and Christ-like care to those in need.

ABOUT US:

The Hope movement is 501 (c)(3) Christian ministry who strives to be an effective mediator between the giving Church and faithful Christian ministries in remote parts of the world.

We provide these ministries financial resources for life-transforming programs, projects, and activities. We provide theological and evangelistic development and resources to edify the body of Christ and proclaim the truth of God's Word to the ends of the earth. We provide logistical guidance to develop efficacious Christ-like mission work. We do this in obedience to God's Word, devotion to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, and love for our neighbor, all for the glory of God alone.

Method to the Mission:

Under the guidance and direction of Jesus Christ, and the leading the Holy Spirit all for the glory of God alone, we desire to serve the LORD faithfully with all our heart (1 Samuel 12:24), considering what great things He has done for us. Declaring His glory among the nations, His marvelous works among all the peoples (Psalm 96:3). We are determined to present ourselves to God as one approved, unashamed, rightly handling the word of truth (2 Timothy 2:15). For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them (Ephesians 2:10).

As a bible-obedient ministry, our first priority is to love the Lord our God with all our heart, with all our soul, and with all our mind (Matthew 22:37). We do this by complete obedience to Scripture as the final authority as the Holy Spirit leads us to develop initiatives that bring glory to God and hope to those in need. We reject the practice of catering to culture and practicing our righteousness before other people in order to be seen by them (Matthew 6:1-4), but rather stand firm on the Word of God and choose Christ over culture, for He is our reward.

We are committed to loving our neighbor as our self (Matthew 22:39). Pouring ourselves out for the hungry and satisfying the desire of the afflicted, so that our light shall rise in the darkness (Isaiah 58:10). In knowing that for our sake God made him to be sin who knew no sin so that in him we might become the righteousness of God, we devote our entire life to proclaiming Christ. We train, equip and teach the body of Christ and conduct evangelistic outreach as ambassadors for Christ, imploring the lost to be reconciled to God through Christ Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:18-21).

We collaborate with authentic biblical believers, ministries, missionaries, and churches around the world to strengthen our united efforts theologically, strategically, logistically and financially. For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, so we, though

many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another (Romans 12:4-5). We are brothers and sisters in Christ, predestined by God for adoption as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of His will (Ephesians 1:5). We want our love to be genuine. Abhorring what is evil; holding fast to what is good. We desire to love one another with brotherly affection. Outdoing one another in showing honor (Romans 12:9-20). As each has received a gift, we will use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace: whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God; whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies—in order that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ (1 Peter 4:10-12).

We cast our hearts upon the poor, the orphan and widow and show Christ-like compassion. With discernment and biblical wisdom, we reach out to those in distress directly and through collaborations to provide care and relief. Where there is thirst, water. Where there is hunger, nutrition. Where there is no home, shelter. Where there is no access to knowledge, education. We are committed to doing that which is pure and undefiled before God, the Father, caring for the orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep ourselves unstained from the world (James 1:27).

Therefore, having this ministry by the mercy of God, we do not lose heart. However, we have renounced disgraceful, underhanded ways. We refuse to practice cunning or to tamper with God's word, but by the open statement of the truth, we would commend ourselves to everyone's conscience in the sight of God. For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ (2 Corinthians 4:1-6).



1 POVERTY RELIEF

Feeding the Hungry

The Hope Movement provides nutrition to those in desperate need of food in collaboration with sharing the Gospel and providing other resources to meet their spiritual and physical development.

Orphan and Widows

The Hope Movement answers the Christian's call to care for the orphan and widow through the support of orphanages and church-based foster programs around the world.

Love of Neighbor

The Hope Movement under the guidance of the Holy Spirit respond to the cries of help from those in need around the world. Help can come in many forms. We serve those in need to break the cycle of poverty and most importantly show the love of Christ not just through deeds but through the preaching of the Gospel so that they may be saved and in Christ Jesus.

Quality Education

The Hope Movement provides scholarships to children so that they can attend school from primary to college. We also develop education programs in our church-based centers to teach children theology, reading, writing and mathematics and assist them with their school studies.

The Hope Movement is planting home churches or assisting established traditional churches to return to their roots following the unique design by God.

Evangelism

HOPE FOR KENYA

In Kenya, Africa there is a wonderful man named Pastor Fredrick Manhanu. He pastors a small church and has a heart for the poor. For the last 5 years Pastor Fredrick has been working with 120 orphans who lost their parents because of HIV/AIDS, Malaria or abandonment. Not

having an orphanage he did something creative, he called upon the church to be the hands of God and open their homes to these precious children. The church members responded and that birthed a foster program where church members are caretakers of these 120 orphans.

PROCLAIMING THE GOSPEL

Along with caring for orphans we now have 25 churches under The Hope Movement - Kenya and a Bible School. We provided them with materials and sound Biblical teaching Bibles in Swahili, training to help them grow in Christ and effectively proclaim the Gospel throughout Africa.

PASTORAL TRAINING CONFERENCE

We provided the funds to send groups of pastors to several conferences which provided further training. It was a life-transforming experience which has produced much fruit.

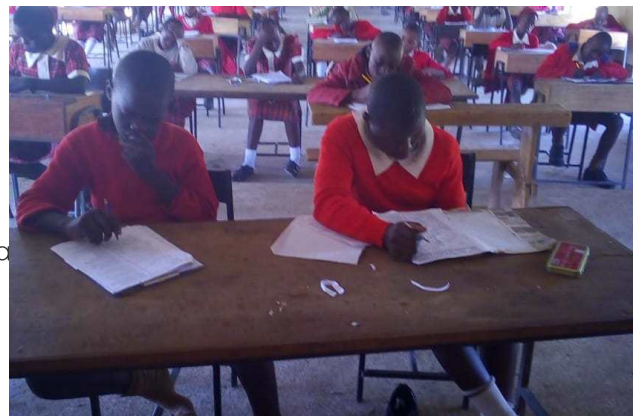

KENYA



URGENT MEDICAL CARE

Thanks to a generous donor we were able to send additional funds to Kenya to cover urgent medical care for 10 ill children who are suffering from different illnesses such as skin disease and typhoid.

We were also able to provide additional mosquito nets to protect the children from malaria.

NEW PROJECTOR FOR BIBLE SCHOOL AND EVANGELISM

In February we were able to send additional funds along with our monthly giving for the orphans to help purchase a new projector. This projector will be utilized in our Bible School to show theological teachings to instruct the students. It will also be used for evangelism purposes to share the gospel through a variety of videos and presentations.

PEOPLE COMING TO CHRIST

People have been coming to Christ all around the regions as we have been doing the house meetings with the bible school students to exercise what they have learned. They are teaching theology, evangelizing to the lost, praying with people and leading discipleship programs to develop new believers to spiritual maturity.

BIBLE SCHOOL

It has been encouraging to see the growth of the Bible school where over 50 students attend to study the Word of God. The school utilizes videos and materials we provide and we are in the process of developing a new curriculum in Swahili which will further develop their knowledge and spiritual maturity.

Out of the Bible school churches have been birthed and planted in communities throughout the region.

PURCHASED A ROOF FOR A SCHOOL

We sent funds to Bungoma, Kenya (Same county where we care for 120 orphans) to Jeff and Stephanie Bys, a missionary couple who have opened an orphanage for nearly 100 children, planted a reformed baptist church and are opened a school called Neema (Grace) Christian Academy. They were building the school which needed to open in a few weeks but they ran out of funds to complete the roof. With the funds we sent they were able to complete the roof and now the children are studying in the new school.



NEW MINISTRY PARTNER

United Ministries Gospel Outreach (UMGO) was founded by Dwight and Cristi Spears and is based in the Philippines where they operate their ministry and offer support wherever there is a need and wherever God leads.

They support churches in the Philippines by shipping supplies from the U.S., distribute Bibles in English and in native languages, provide biblical materials, assist in church planting and building, provide educational supplies

to local children, conduct Bible studies and strive to edify the body of Christ in many other unique ways.

As a ministry partner with The Hope Movement we have the vision to support them by raising needing funds, allowing them to focus on ministry and providing for the many needs, provide evangelistic supplies, and assist them in proclaiming the gospel and helping those in need.

2019 HIGHLIGHTS

Many exciting moments took place in 2019 and here

are just a few highlights.

- Distribution of Bibles throughout the country.
- Renovation for a poor church and construction of benches.
- Provision of food distribution to feeding programs operated by local churches.
- Distribution of clothing, books and toys to poor children.
- Gospel presentations in various churches, fishing communities and remote areas.
- Provision of back to school supplies for hundreds of children.

GUATEMALA



In 2019, we continued supporting two feeding centers serving those in need and teaching the Bible providing thousands of meals. We were also by the grace of God able to help another project in Chiquimula, Guatemala who are serving the poor living and working in the trash dump. We were able to conduct our best mission trip to date. We were able to travel hours in different directions to preach the gospel in churches, hospitals, shelters, prisons, trash dumps, police department and in the mountains while also feeding the hungry, distributing clothing and painting a shelter.

PROJECT 003: NUEVO AMANECER

This center is located in Guatemala City in Nuevo Amanecer providing weekly meals, counseling, and Biblical theology classes.

PROJECT 005: VILLA LOBOS

This center is located in Guatemala City in Villa Lobos providing weekly meals, counseling, and Biblical theology classes.

PROVIDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL HELP

We helped a Christian family in the mountains of San Juan Sacatepequez, Their son Pedro Jose was having convulsions and has fluid on the brain. The financial assistance helped cover the emergency surgery and after care.

MISSION TRIP

In June we traveled to Guatemala with a small team. On the first day we traveled to a town called Villa Lobos where we taught theology with questions and answers. We then shared the gospel, sang songs with the children and served meals to each child. In the evening we preached on Adoption from Ephesian 1.

The following day we traveled to the mountains where we preached a sermon and shared the gospel, feed the children, had fund with pinatas and gave funds for medical care for Pedro. That evening we went to a church that spoke English and a young man who was deported from the U.S. showed up and we were able to share

the gospel with him.

The next day we traveled 4 hours to Chiquimula to preach at trash dumps where we also distributed clothing, a prison, shelter where we also painted the building, in the hospital, at a police station and conducted a radio interview where we shared the gospel to many listeners.

We then drove 5 hours south to Escuintla to visit children we have known for years to spend some time with them and share the gospel.



BALTIMORE



The Hope Movement working along with local churches, community leaders and the community itself has a vision to develop a strategic plan of action to transform the most impoverished communities in Baltimore City into havens of hope.

FROM VACANT LOTS TO HAVENS OF HOPE

Baltimore City has developed an agreement with The Hope Movement to adopt and manage vacant lots where gangs, poverty, drugs, alcoholism, violence and family dysfunction are consuming the people. The Hope Movement mobilizes a local movement of people from churches, businesses and individuals from the

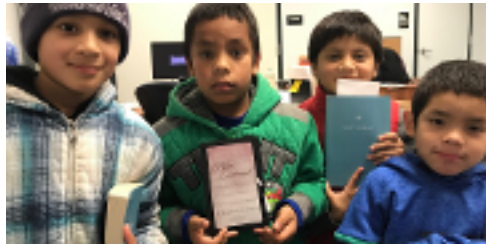
community to unite and volunteer their time to develop these lots into community gardens, safe parks for families and we provide food programs, prayer and evangelism.

The vacant lots we have been working on in 2019 are located on the notorious North Avenue, known for the riots in 2015 and was abandoned with high grass, hanging branches, trash, mattresses for the homeless and prostitution, drug needles and more. However, today its a place with flowers, vegetables for the community, places to sit, signs with Bible verses with a beautiful fence creating a haven of hope in the midst of despair.

EVANGELISM

The Hope Movement has teams working on community development in the garden and feeding programs and another team for evangelism. We preach the Gospel with boldness to open eyes through the power of the Holy Spirit and His Word planting seeds in their hearts and calling them to repentance.





BALTIMORE

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

In 2019, God expanded our team of local missionaries from various churches. The work has really become a special ministry for our local church Faith Fellowship. It has been wonderful to see the body of Christ uniting as one to proclaim the gospel, pray with people, feed the hungry, distribute clothing, care for the community garden while encouraging other brothers and sisters in Christ.

Throughout the year we not only maintained the community garden and planted flowers and vegetables. We had many opportunities to street preach and pray with people, sharing the gospel and the hope only found in Christ.

We conduct mission activities multiple times a month serving over 1,500 people. Just to share about a couple of the outreaches in February we were serving food and we were informed of a young woman considering suicide. They got us and we went to her. We spent at least an hour with her sharing the gospel and by the end of the conversation she was repenting of her sins. We gave her a Bible, taught her how to read it along with some other resources. We gave Spanish and English Bibles to a Hispanic family who desired a Bible of their own. In November we had a full course Thanksgiving meal. We served a complete thanksgiving dinner to about 100 people in the

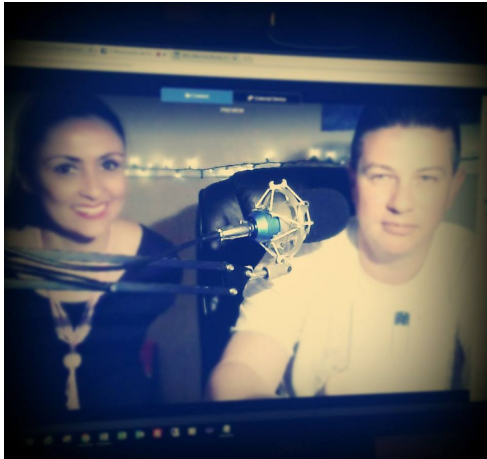
community, shared the gospel and prayed for individuals.

Through a simple community garden that was a vacant lot in a dangerous part of the city, God has provided wonderful opportunities to pray with people and share the love of Christ.

We have met so many lovely people and pray that God will use this to inspire the church to go into this place and evangelize and plant a church, discipling many to become authentic followers of Christ.

May God be glorified and people come to Christ.





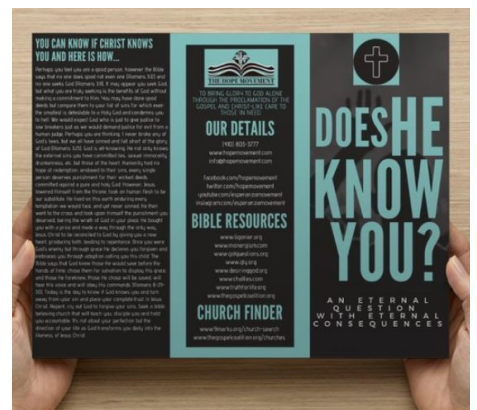
THEOLOGY FAMINE RELIEF

We are called to share not our biblical interpretations, not a denomination biblical interpretation but teach what the Bible actually says while understanding that there are many subjects in the bible which are a mystery but because of our faith in Jesus Christ and the sovereignty of our awesome God we trust in His word, even in the areas which are difficult for humans to understand. Because of our fear of God and love of His word, we carefully teach indisputable truths of the Bible in order to glorify God and bring man to a deeper understanding of Him allowing the Holy Spirit to regenerate souls to bring them to repentance and salvation.

The Hope Movement produces materials and teaches using a systematic theology approach. "Systematic" refers to something being put into a system. Systematic theology is, therefore, the division of theology into systems that explain its various areas.

The Hope Movement along with preaching the Gospel and teaching theology in churches, conferences, seminars and outreach missions, we also preach and teach through our online broadcast in various languages every week, which have been watched by hundreds of people around the world.

In 2019 we continued our weekly theology classes in English and Spanish, designed shirts with theology words and Bible verses to share the Gospel, published Gospel tracts and teaching guides in various languages, and trained pastors from Kenya and other countries. Hope Movement Publications now publishes books and are sold or given freely.

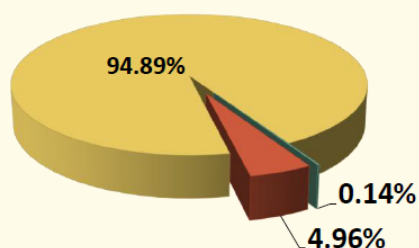

We work diligently to limit our overhead costs, while maximizing quality child and family focused program activities. As a result, less than 1% of funds are used for administration.

BECOME A CHEERFUL GIVER

You are The Hope Movement, we are a team in the work of God, we can not fulfill our calling without you. Just as our calling is to go and work in the mission field to transform lives, you have a profound calling to give to help sustain the work being accomplished.

As the word of God has directed us in 2 Corinthians 9, "Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
